


"WHAT IS INFORMATION AND REFERRAL AND HOW CAN IT HELP ME?"

Yes! ReferWeb is an innovative, web-based information and referral application that allows the public to search for provider agencies and services on their own. This method of information and referral significantly increases customer accessibility and customization.



"HOW DO I ACCESS ReferWeb?"

ReferWeb is accessible on any computer that has an internet connection. The following three steps will successfully guide you to ReferWeb:

1. In your web browser address bar, type in www.referweb.net/chesco
2. For Spanish, click on the down arrow next to the "Select Language" box in the upper right corner of the ReferWeb home page.
3. Enter information to search database.
