**APPROVING A FINANCING BY CHESTER COUNTY
INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF A
PROJECT FOR THE HICKMAN FRIENDS SENIOR
COMMUNITY OF WEST CHESTER**

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements of the Tax Equity and Fiscal Responsibility Act of 1982, as amended, the Chester County Industrial Development Authority (the "Authority"), after publicizing notice thereof in a newspaper of general circulation, held a public hearing on July 20, 2016 regarding the application of The Hickman Friends Senior Community of West Chester ("Project Applicant") for the financing of its capital project (as more fully described in the attached public notice announcement, the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined that the Project conforms to the public purpose, eligibility and financial responsibility requirements of the Pennsylvania Economic Development Financing Law, and, at its July 20, 2016 meeting, approved the Project and the issuance by the Authority, in favor of RJ Sims (the "Bond Underwriter"), of its tax-exempt note in the maximum amount of \$20,000,000 (the "Note"), the proceeds of which will be loaned by the Authority to the Project Applicant to fund a portion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, 26 U.S.C. §147(f) (the "Code"), requires that the applicable elected representatives of the governmental unit on behalf of which bonds are issued and of a governmental unit having jurisdiction over the area in which any financed facility is located approve private activity bonds after a public hearing in order for such bond to be a bond qualifying for tax-exemption under the Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners constitutes the appropriate elected representative for the purposes of giving approval under Section 147(f) of the Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 147(f), the Project Applicant and the Authority have requested the Board of County Commissioners to approve the issuance of the Note for the purposes of Section 147(f) of the Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Chester County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Project, as defined in the preambles hereto, and the issuance of the Note by the Authority is hereby approved, it being understood that such approval shall not, directly or indirectly, obligate the taxing power of Chester County or otherwise obligate Chester County in any way whatsoever.

SECTION 2. The foregoing determination, declaration and approval are for the purposes of the applicable provisions of the Code and do not constitute approval for any permit, license or zoning required for the construction or occupancy of any facilities to be financed or refinanced as part of the Project.

SECTION 3. All actions of this Board of Commissioners of Chester County taken in conformity with the intents and purposes of these Resolutions are ratified, confirmed and approved in all respects.

SECTION 4. These Resolutions shall take effect immediately. All prior resolutions or portions thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CHESTER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING
THE CONVEYANCE OF A CERTAIN PARCEL OF REAL PROPERTY THAT WAS
FORMERLY A RAILROAD RIGHT OF WAY SITUATE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF
WEST NANTMEAL, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA TO THE MILLER FARM
FAMILY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP AS CONSIDERATION FOR THE GRANT OF A
TRAIL EASEMENT**

WHEREAS, Chester County is the owner of a formal railroad right of way (the "ROW") having acquired the same by Quit Claim Deed November 6, 1998, and recorded December 19, 1989 in the Office for the Recorder of Deeds in and for Chester County, Pennsylvania, in Record Book 1816, page 229; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the ROW has been identified as Chester County Tax Parcel No. 23-2-41-E; and

WHEREAS, the County intends to construct a public recreational trail known as the Hibernia Trail primarily within the ROW; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the ROW traverses property owned by the Miller Farm Family Limited Partnership (the "Partnership") in West Nantmeal Township, which property is identified as Chester County Tax Parcel Number 23-2-37; and

WHEREAS, the Partnership has requested that the County convey all of the County's right, title and interest in the portion of the ROW that traverses Parcel 23-2-37 in exchange for the Partnership granting a trail easement across the frontage of Parcel 23-2-37 where it abuts Manor Road (S.R. 0082); and

WHEREAS, the County has agreed to execute a quit claim deed relinquishing all of the County's right, title and interest in the portion of the ROW which traverses Parcel 23-2-37 provided that the Partnership executes a trail easement agreement in favor of the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the agents, servants, employees, representatives and Solicitor of Chester County are hereby directed to take all actions as may be required to execute a quit claim deed for the portion of the ROW identified as Chester County Tax Parcel No. 23-2-41-E which bisects Parcel 23-2-37 and to execute a Trail Easement Agreement with the Partnership provided that the Partnership executes the Trail Easement Agreement.
