**Adopted October \_\_\_\_\_, 2015**

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT IT IS DESIRABLE FOR THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE COUNTY OF CHESTER FOR THE CHESTER COUNTY HEALTH AND EDUCATION FACILITIES AUTHORITY TO UNDERTAKE A PROJECT INVOLVING THE ISSUANCE OF REVENUE BONDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$70,000,000; APPROVING THE PROJECT UNDER SECTION 147(f) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986, AS AMENDED; AND REPEALING ALL PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS.

The following recitals are a part of this Resolution.

A. Simpson Senior Services (the "Corporation") has requested the Chester County Health and Education Facilities Authority (the "Authority") to approve a financing which will include, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipality Authorities Act, Act 22 of 2001, 53 Pa.C.S. §5601 et seq., as amended (the "Authorities Act") the issuance of Authority's Revenue Bonds, Series 2015 in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$70,000,000 (collectively, the "2015 Bonds").

B. The Corporation has asked the Authority to issue its revenue bonds (the "2015 Bonds") to finance the project described on Exhibit "A" hereto (the "2015 Project").

C. The Authorities Act authorizes the financing of the 2015 Project for the Corporation and with respect to the 2015 Project, and certain other projects, requires that "each municipality organizing an Authority . . . shall declare by resolution or ordinance that it is desirable for the health, safety and welfare of the people in the area served by such facilities to have such facilities . . . financed through (the) Authority." 53 Pa.C.S. §5607(B)(2)(IV).

D. Pursuant to the Authorities Act, the Corporation and the Authority have requested the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Chester (the "Board of County Commissioners") to declare, by this resolution that the 2015 Project is desirable for the health, safety and welfare of the people in the area served by the Corporation.

E. Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, 26 U.S.C. §147(f) (the "Code"), requires that the applicable elected representatives of the governmental unit on behalf of which bonds are issued and of each governmental unit having jurisdiction over the area in which any facility, is located, approve bonds after a public hearing in order for a private activity bond to be a qualified bond under the Code.

F. The Board of County Commissioners constitutes the appropriate elected representatives for the purposes of giving Section 147(f) approvals.

G. On September 21, 2015, the Authority held a hearing in compliance with Section



147(f) pursuant to public notice.

H. The Authority approved the 2015 Project and the 2015 Bonds on October 2, 2015.

I. Pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Code, the Corporation and the Authority have requested the Board of County Commissioners to approve the issuance of the 2015 Bonds for the purposes of Section 147(f) of the Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Chester as follows:

SECTION 1. It is hereby determined and declared pursuant to the Authorities Act that it is desirable for the health, safety and welfare of the people in the area served by the Corporation for the Authority to undertake the financing of the 2015 Project through the issuance of the 2015 Bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$70,000,000.

SECTION 2. The issuance of the 2015 Bonds and the financing of the 2015 Project are hereby approved for purposes of Section 147(f) of the Code.

SECTION 3. The foregoing determination, declaration and approval are for the purposes of the applicable provisions of the Authorities Act and the Code and do not constitute approval for any permit, license or zoning required for the construction or occupancy of any facilities to be financed or refinanced as part of the 2015 Project.

SECTION 4. The adoption of this Resolution is not a pledge of any revenues or security by the County of Chester. Neither the credit nor the taxing power of the County of Chester, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, or any political subdivision, agency or instrumentality thereof is pledged for payment of the 2015 Bonds.

SECTION 5. All actions of this Board of County Commissioners taken in conformity with the intents and purposes of this Resolution are ratified, confirmed and approved in all respects.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately. All prior ordinances or resolutions or portions thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

## EXHIBIT "A" - THE PROJECT

- (1) The refinancing on behalf of Simpson House of the Narberth Borough Industrial Development Authority Revenue Bonds, Series of 2012 (Simpson House Project) which refinanced the Philadelphia Authority for Industrial Development Revenue Refunding Bonds (Simpson House Project) Series of 1998 (the "1998 Bonds"). The 1998 Bonds advance refunded bonds which financed a project for Simpson House consisting generally of financing construction of and renovations to its continuing care retirement community.
- (2) Capital improvements and equipment acquisition for Simpson House including the renovation of the Flanagan Health and Rehabilitation Center (including converting 36 beds to 20 short term stay beds and adding 2 additional double occupancy rooms) (including refinancing costs financed by an outstanding line of credit).
- (3) The refinancing on behalf of Simpson Meadows of the Authority's Revenue Bonds, Series of 2010 (Simpson Meadows Project) (the "2010 Bonds") which refinanced the Authority's Revenue Bonds (Simpson Meadows Project) Series 2000 (the "2000 Bonds"). The 2000 Bonds financed a project for Simpson Meadows consisting generally of the construction and equipping of its retirement community.
- (4) Miscellaneous capital improvements and equipment acquisition for Simpson Meadows.
- (5) The refinancing on behalf of Jenners Pond of the Authority's Variable Rate Bonds, Series 2006 (Jenners Pond Project) (the "2006 Bonds") (including a termination payment for a related swap) which refinanced the Authority's Revenue Bonds Senior Living Facility Revenue Bonds, Series 2002 (Jenners Pond, Inc. Project) (the "2002 Bonds") and a note of Jenners Pond (the "Note"). The 2002 Bonds and the Note financed or refinanced various capital projects for Jenners Pond.
- (6) Miscellaneous capital improvements and equipment acquisition for Jenners Pond (including refinancing costs financed by an outstanding line of credit).
- (7) Funded interest on the Bonds and a deposit to a debt service reserve fund.
- (8) Costs of issuance of the Bonds.

**RESOLUTION OF THE CHESTER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING  
PARTICIPATION IN THE STEPPING UP PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, counties routinely provide treatment services to the estimated 2 million people with serious mental illnesses booked into jail each year; and

**WHEREAS**, prevalence rates of serious mental illnesses in jails are three to six times higher than for the general population; and

**WHEREAS**, almost three-quarters of adults with serious mental illnesses in jails have existing or recurring substance abuse issues; and

**WHEREAS**, adults with mental illnesses tend to stay longer in jail and upon release are at a higher risk of recidivism than people without these disorders; and

**WHEREAS**, county jails expend more time and financial resources on inmates with mental illnesses that require specialized intervention/assistance compared to those inmates without these treatment needs; and

**WHEREAS**, without the appropriate treatment and services, people with mental illnesses will continue to cycle through the criminal justice system, often resulting in adverse consequences for these individuals and their families; and

**WHEREAS**, Chester County, Pennsylvania, as well as all counties throughout the Commonwealth take pride in undertaking the responsibility to protect and enhance the health, safety and welfare of residents in efficient and cost-effective ways; and

**WHEREAS**, Chester County has initiated various mental health based programs through its various departmental agencies to address not only mental health issues in the criminal justice system but also throughout the County in furtherance of assuring the health, safety and welfare of its residents and those seeking a multitude of County health and human services; and

**WHEREAS**, seeking to explore additional options, alternatives, and understanding, through the *Stepping Up* initiative, the National Association of Counties, the Council of State Governments Justice Center and the American Psychiatric Association Foundation are encouraging public, private and nonprofit partners to review, consider and move to reduce the number of people with mental illnesses in jails;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, THAT,** the Chester County Commissioners, do hereby sign on to the Call to Action to reduce the number of people with mental illnesses in the criminal justice system and more specifically the Chester County Prison, commit to sharing lessons learned with other counties in the Commonwealth as well as across the nation to support a national initiative and encourage all county officials, employees and residents to participate in *Stepping Up*. We resolve to utilize the comprehensive resources available through *Stepping Up* to:

- Convene or draw on a diverse team of leaders and decision makers from multiple agencies committed to safely reducing the number of people with mental illnesses in jails.
- Collect and review prevalence numbers and assess individual needs to better identify adults entering jails with mental illnesses and their recidivism risk, and use that baseline information to guide decision making at the system, program, and case levels.
- Examine treatment and service capacity to determine which programs and services are available in the County for people with mental illnesses and co-occurring substance use disorders, and identify state and local policy and funding barriers toward minimizing contact with the justice system and otherwise providing treatment and supports in the community.
- Develop a plan with measurable outcomes that draws on the jail assessment and prevalence data and the examination of available treatment and service capacity, while considering identified barriers.
- Implement research-based approaches that advance the plan.
- Create a process to track progress using data and information systems, and to report on successes.
