BOARD OF ELECTIONS MINUTES

October 14, 2020

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Chair Marian D. Moskowitz of the Chester County Board of Commissioners called the Board of Elections Meeting to order on Wednesday, October 14, 2020 at 9:31 AM via teleconference. Commissioner Josh Maxwell and Commissioner Michelle Kichline were also present.

**RESOLUTION OF THE CHESTER COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS
AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY CHANGE OF POLLING LOCATION FOR THE 2020
GENERAL ELECTION**

WHEREAS, the Chester County Board of Elections is required to select and designate polling places within the County, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Election Code (25 P.S. § 2726, *et seq.*) prior to the November 3, 2020 General Election; and

WHEREAS, the Chester County Board of Elections may change a polling location within 13 days of the November 3, 2020 General Election resulting from emergency or unavoidable event; and

WHEREAS, the Chester County Board of Elections has learned that the proposed host for the poll designated as “249 – East Goshen 7” has indicated that it does not have the space to host two different precincts for the 2020 General Election; and

WHEREAS, the Chester County Board of Elections is aware that COVID-19 still poses a very serious health risk to the community and it could present a public health risk to require two precincts to fit into a small venue; and

WHEREAS, the Chester County Board of Elections is aware that it is anticipated that there will be significant voter turnout for the November 3, 2020 General Election; and

WHEREAS, the Chester County Board of Elections finds that relocating the polling precinct known as “249 – East Goshen 7” in order to have ample spacing for voters as follows:

249 – East Goshen 7

From: East Goshen United Church of Christ – 1201 E Boot Road, West Chester, PA

To: **East Goshen Elementary School, 800 North Chester Road, West Chester, PA**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHESTER COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS that precinct polling place 249 – East Goshen 7 is relocated to East Goshen Elementary School, 800 North Chester Road, West Chester, PA as set forth above for the November 3, 2020 General Election consistent with this Resolution’s directives.
