THE COUNTY OF CHESTER COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA RESOLUTION No. 44-17

RESOLUTION OF THE CHESTER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH OF DOWNINGTOWN'S LERTA BOUNDARY DESIGNATION

-_____

WHEREAS, on December 1, 1977, as Act No. 76 of 1977, the Pennsylvania Legislature adopted the Local Economic Revitalization Tax Assistance Act ("LERTA"), which authorizes local taxing authorities to exempt improvements to certain deteriorated industrial, commercial and other business property;

WHEREAS, Borough Council of the Borough of Downingtown ("Borough"), in accordance with LERTA, held a public hearing on October 4, 2017 to determine the boundaries of said areas which shall be identified as "Deteriorated Areas"; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council, at the conclusion of the public hearing, enacted Resolution 2017-10, which identified the Deteriorated Areas within the Borough that are eligible for tax exemption pursuant to Borough Ordinance 2017-8, also enacted on October 4, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Downingtown Area School District, by Resolution executed on September 13, 2017, approved the same LERTA program boundaries as designated by the Borough and has likewise agreed to participate in the LERTA program as set forth in the Borough's Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, by this Resolution, the Chester County Commissioners hereby agree to the Borough's designation of the LERTA program boundaries and hereby concur with the provisions of the aforesaid Borough Ordinance and Resolution, within and consistent to the terms, conditions and limitations provided in the Act. Specifically, the Exemption Amount for Chester County shall be \$69,810 and commence effective the 2019 tax year. The real property taxes associated with the assessment attributable to the improvements shall be exempted until such time when the total amount exempted is equal to the above indicated Exemption Amount but shall not be exempted for greater than ten years from the Borough Ordinance's effective date.
