RESOLUTION OF THE CHESTER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING SIGNATURE AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation (Department) and the County Of Chester (Municipality) under the date of May 15, 1997 entered into Agreement No. 062645 and subsequent supplements A through E, wherein the Commonwealth and the Municipality agreed to participate in a Non-Federal Aid Highway Program to construct the replacement of the Valley Road Bridge over the Branch of White Clay Creek (#248); and

WHEREAS, the design of said construction of replacement of the Valley Road Bridge over the Branch of White Clay Creek has shown that this bridge project will require the adjustment of certain of West Grove Borough facilities, portions of which are presently outside the existing public right of way; and

WHEREAS, West Grove Borough has executed the attached agreement to address all issues between the parties; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto, for and in consideration of the foregoing promises and mutual promises set forth in the attached agreement between The County of Chester and West Grove Borough, with the intention of being legally bound hereby agree as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the authority of the Board of County Commissioners of Chester County, that the Chairman of the Board be authorized and directed to singularly execute the attached agreement on behalf of the entirety of the Board of Commissioners, and in doing so, agrees to be legally bound to the terms, conditions and provisions set forth by the agreements and the Chief Clerk be authorized and directed to attest to the same.

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2016, by and between the COUNTY of CHESTER in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, hereinafter called the MUNICIPALITY,

WEST GROVE BOROUGH with its principal place of business located at 117 Rosehill Avenue, P.O. Box 61, West Grove, Pennsylvania, hereinafter called UTILITY.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the MUNICIPALITY is about to undertake a highway construction project located on S.R. 0000, Section BRG, County Bridge #248, between Station 1+85 and Station 10+00 and located in London Grove, Chester County, Pennsylvania; and,

WHEREAS, this highway construction project is being constructed pursuant to the terms of Agreement Number 062645 dated May 15, 1997, as supplemented, entered into between the MUNICIPALITY and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, hereinafter Department, which provides, inter alia, that the Department is acting as an agent of the Federal Highway Administration to coordinate the design and construction of the project; and,

WHEREAS, the highway construction project is to be participated in by the Federal Highway Administration, U. S. Department of Transportation and the Department; and,

WHEREAS, this highway project will require the adjustment of certain of the UTILITY's facilities, portions of which are presently located outside the existing public right of way; and,

WHEREAS, any such facilities transferred to or remaining at a location within the right of way of a Federally aided highway will be accommodated in accordance with the provisions of the current 23 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 645, Subpart B, of the Federal Highway Administration, United States Department of Transportation; and,

WHEREAS, the MUNICIPALITY has notified and will require the UTILITY to adjust certain of its facilities to accommodate the highway project and has agreed to enter into this agreement with the UTILITY to contribute toward the expense of the adjustment of those existing facilities for which the UTILITY has a real property interest compensable under the law of eminent domain.

WHEREAS, all utility work performed pursuant to this Agreement must comply with the "Buy America" provisions in 23 U.S.C. §313 and 23 CFR §635.410 and the Steel Products Procurement Act, 73 P.S. §1881 et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE:

In consideration of the foregoing premises and the mutual covenants hereinafter contained and with the intent to be legally bound hereby, the Parties agree as follows:

FIRST – That the UTILITY has agreed to incur all costs associated with the design of the relocation of its facilities consisting of water and sanitary sewer, together with fittings and appurtenances thereto between Stations 1+85 and 10+00, on State Route 0000, Section BRG, County Bridge #248, in the London Grove, Chester County.

SECOND - That the MUNICIPALITY has agreed to make the adjustments to the UTILITY's facilities as authorized by letter from the UTILITY dated September 22, 2015, consisting of water, together with fittings and appurtenances thereto between Stations 1+85 and 10+00, on State Route 0000, Section BRG, County Bridge #248, in the London Grove, Chester County, in the manner and at the location approved by the MUNICIPALITY at the sole cost of the MUNICIPALITY. Detailed cost estimates and plans showing the adjustments of the UTILITY's facilities are in the possession of the Parties.

THIRD - It is further agreed that if, for any reason, the highway construction project referred to herein shall be cancelled, abandoned, or revised, in such a manner that the work described in Section SECOND of this Agreement should no longer be required, then in such event, the MUNICIPALITY will restore the UTILITY's s system to normal operating conditions.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the MUNICIPALITY and the UTILITY have caused this Agreement to be duly executed, ensealed and attested by their proper officials, pursuant to due and legal action authorizing the same to be done, the day and year first above written.
