District Attorney Announces Hiring of New Chester County Detectives

Chester County District Attorney Tom Hogan announced the hiring of two new members of the Chester County Detectives. James F. Ciliberto and Thomas J. Goggin will be sworn in as Chester County Detectives at 3:30 p.m. today in Courtroom 2 before President Judge James P. MacElree II.

District Attorney Hogan stated, "Jim Ciliberto and Tom Goggin are experienced, aggressive, and dedicated investigators. They have worked with and earned the respect of law enforcement throughout Pennsylvania. The Chester County Detectives are continuing to add to their already strong ranks."

Prior to joining the Chester County Detectives, Ciliberto was a Trooper with the Pennsylvania State Police – Avondale Barracks for over 20 years. He has extensive experience working homicide, child abuse, and other major cases. He is a graduate of West Chester University, earning his degree *summa cum laude* in History. He has been named Trooper of the Year on multiple occasions.

Goggin joins the Chester County Detectives after over 20 years with the Phoenixville Police Department. He has expertise in dealing with street crime, child abuse, and complex investigations. He received his undergraduate degree in Organizational Management from Eastern College and his master's degree in Criminal Justice from West Chester University.

District Attorney Hogan added, "Detectives Ciliberto and Goggin have demonstrated their abilities over the years and they know Chester County backwards and forwards. With their addition, the Chester County Detectives will continue to work with law enforcement across the county to keep Chester County a safe place to live, work, and raise a family."
