**District Attorney Swears In Two New
Prosecutors, Names Head of Child Abuse Unit**

Chester County District Attorney Tom Hogan announced the swearing-in of two new prosecutors, Kelsey Gvozdich and Ryan Borchik. The two new Assistant District Attorneys both recently passed the Pennsylvania Bar Examination and will be sworn in before Chester County Court of Common Pleas Judge Mark L. Tunnell at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, November 1, 2013.

Ms. Gvozdich received her undergraduate degree from Juniata College and her law degree from Widener University School of Law. She previously served as an intern in the District Attorney's Office.

Mr. Borchik received his undergraduate degree from Washington & Jefferson College and his law degree from the George Washington University School of Law. He previously served as an intern in the Office of the State's Attorney for Baltimore, Maryland.

District Attorney Hogan stated, "Year after year, Chester County is lucky enough to hire talented and dedicated prosecutors to work with our police to keep Chester County a safe place to live, work, and raise a family. Kelsey and Ryan are now a part of that outstanding tradition and will serve the people of Chester County honorably and with distinction."

District Attorney Hogan also announced that Deborah Ryan has been promoted to the position of Deputy District Attorney in charge of the Child Abuse Unit. Ms. Ryan received her undergraduate degree from Boston University and her law degree from the University of Pittsburgh Law School. She has been a

prosecutor with the Chester County District Attorney's Office for seven years. She came to Chester County after serving in the Philadelphia District Attorney's Office.

District Attorney Hogan stated, "The Deputy District Attorney in charge of the Child Abuse Unit has a tremendous responsibility. I have every confidence in Deb's ability to continue the vital work of protecting Chester County's children."
