SHEEP

Baby sheep are called lambs. They are born in the early spring. Sheep are sheared for wool to make clothes and blankets.

HORSE

The horses eat hay and grass in the pasture. They sleep in the barn. Donkeys are also members of the horse family.

TRACTOR

The tractor helps the farmer till, plant and harvest the fields.

GOAT

The mother goat is called a doe. The father is called a buck and the babies are called kids!

CHICKEN

The fuzzy yellow peeps grow to be chickens. They eat grain and insects.

PIG

The sow is the mother pig. Her babies are called piglets. They grow very fast and are very smart.

CORN

Corn is one of the many crops grown on the farm. It is stored in silos and used to feed the animals.

COW




The cows at Springton are beef cattle. In summer, a cow can drink more than 20 gallons of water a day!


