

**PETITION BY THE CHESTER COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS
TO DIVIDE THE VOTING DISTRICT KNOWN AS
VALLEY NORTH**

NOW COMES your Petitioner, the Chester County Board of Elections, and prays that this Honorable Court enter an Order dividing the voting precinct known as Valley North and, in support thereof, avers the following:

1. Your Petitioner is the duly elected and constituted Board of Elections for the County of Chester in Pennsylvania (hereinafter "the Board").
2. Upon petition of the Board, this Honorable Court may enter an Order dividing any precinct for the convenience of the electors and in the public interest. 25 P.S. § 2704.
3. The Board has decided that the convenience of the electors of said precinct and the public interest will be served by splitting said precinct.
4. The new precincts will be known as Valley North 1 (670), Valley North 2 (671), and Valley North 3 (672).
5. Attached hereto is a verbal description of the boundary of the proposed precincts as Exhibit A.

6. Attached hereto is a map of the old precinct boundaries as Exhibit B.
7. Attached hereto is a map of the proposed precinct boundaries as Exhibit C.
8. The voter registration, as of the immediately preceding election is: 1,298 for Valley North 1 (670); 1,351 for Valley North 2 (671); and 1,299 for Valley North 3 (672).
9. The polling places for each precinct are: Valley Baptist Church for Valley North 1 (670); James J. Terry Funeral Home for Valley North 2 (671); and Rainbow Elementary School for Valley North 3 (672).

Valley North Revised Boundary Line Narratives

Precinct 1

Start at the intersection of the Amtrak Philadelphia – Pittsburgh main line and the border between Valley Twp and Sadsbury Twp. Head north along the muni boundary line and then northeast along the same line to Wagontown Rd. Then head south along Wagontown Rd to the intersection of Rt 30 Bypass. Head west along the Rt 30 Bypass to Country Club Rd. Then head south along Country Club Rd to W Lincoln Hwy where Country Club Rd becomes Rainbow Rd. Follow Rainbow Rd south to the intersection of Front St. Head east on Front St to Church St. Head north on Church St to W Lincoln Hwy. Head southeast on W Lincoln Hwy to Main St. Head southwest on Main St to Highland Av. Head south on Highland Av to George St. Head west on George St to the end of George St. Then follow the border of census block 1034 south to the intersection with the Amtrak Philadelphia – Pittsburgh main line. Follow the Amtrak Philadelphia – Pittsburgh main line west to the point of beginning.

Precinct 2

Start at the intersection of Rt 30 Bypass and Country Club Rd. Then head south along Country Club Rd to W Lincoln Hwy where Country Club Rd becomes Rainbow Rd. Follow Rainbow Rd south to the intersection of Front St. Head east on Front St to Church St. Head north on Church St to W Lincoln Hwy. Head southeast on W Lincoln Hwy to Main St. Head southwest on Main St to Highland Av. Head south on Highland Av to George St. Head west on George St to the end of George St. Then follow the border of census block 1034 south to the intersection with the Amtrak Philadelphia – Pittsburgh main line. Follow the Amtrak Philadelphia – Pittsburgh main line to its intersection with the northwest corner of Census Block 1043. Then south to the border between Valley Twp and Coatesville City. Then northeast along that boundary. Then north along that border to E Glencrest Rd. Then west along E Glencrest Rd to Glencrest Rd. Then north along Glencrest Rd to Irish La. Then northeast along Irish La to Ash St. Then north then east along Ash St. Follow along north side of Census Block 3050 to Wagontown Rd. Then north and northwest along Wagontown Rd to Rt 30 Bypass. Then west along Rt 30 Bypass to the point of beginning.

Precinct 3

West Part

Start at the intersection of E Glencrest Rd and the border between Valley Twp and Coatesville City. Then west along E Glencrest Rd to Glencrest Rd. Then north along Glencrest Rd to Irish La. Then northeast along Irish La to Ash St. Then north then east along Ash St. Follow along

north side of Census Block 3050 to Wagontown Rd. Then north and northwest along Wagontown Rd to the border between Valley Twp and West Caln Twp. Then northeast along that border to the border of Valley Twp, West Caln Twp and Coatesville City. Then south and then west along that border to the intersection of Manor Rd and Valley Station Rd. Then southwest along Manor Rd to Wagontown Rd. Then south along Wagontown Rd. Then follow the border between Valley Twp and Coatesville City to the point of beginning.

East Part

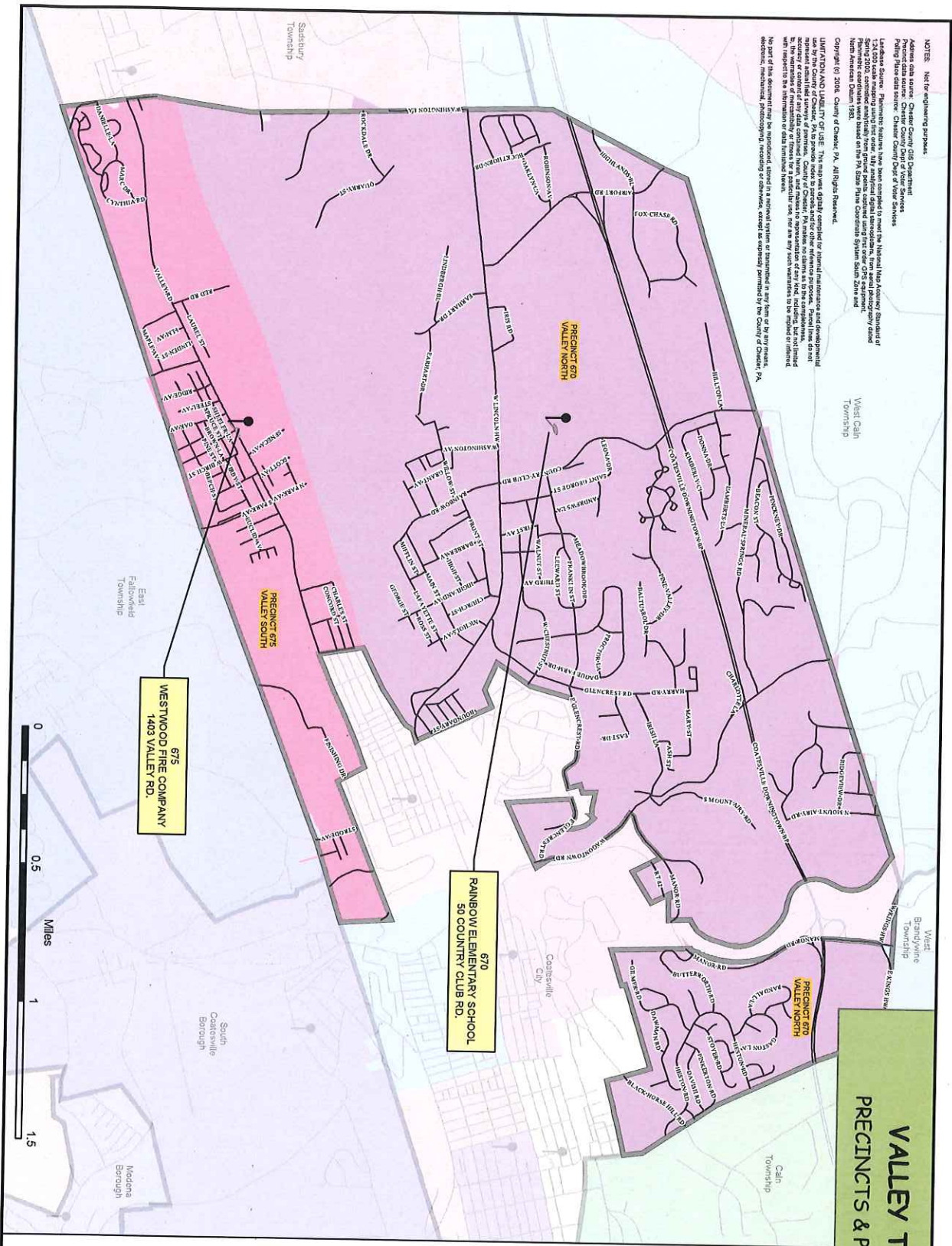
Start at the border of Valley Twp, Caln Twp and West Brandywine Twp. Follow south along the border of Valley Twp and Caln Twp to the intersection of the borders between Valley Twp, Caln Twp and Coatesville City. Follow the border between Valley Twp and Coatesville City west, then north, then west, then north to intersection of W Kings Hwy. Follow W Kings Hwy west to intersection of Valley Twp, West Brandywine Twp and Coatesville City. Then east along the border of Valley Twp and West Brandywine Twp to Manor Dr. Then south along Manor Dr E Kings Hwy. Then northeast, then east along E Kings Hwy to the point of beginning.

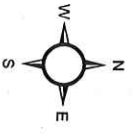

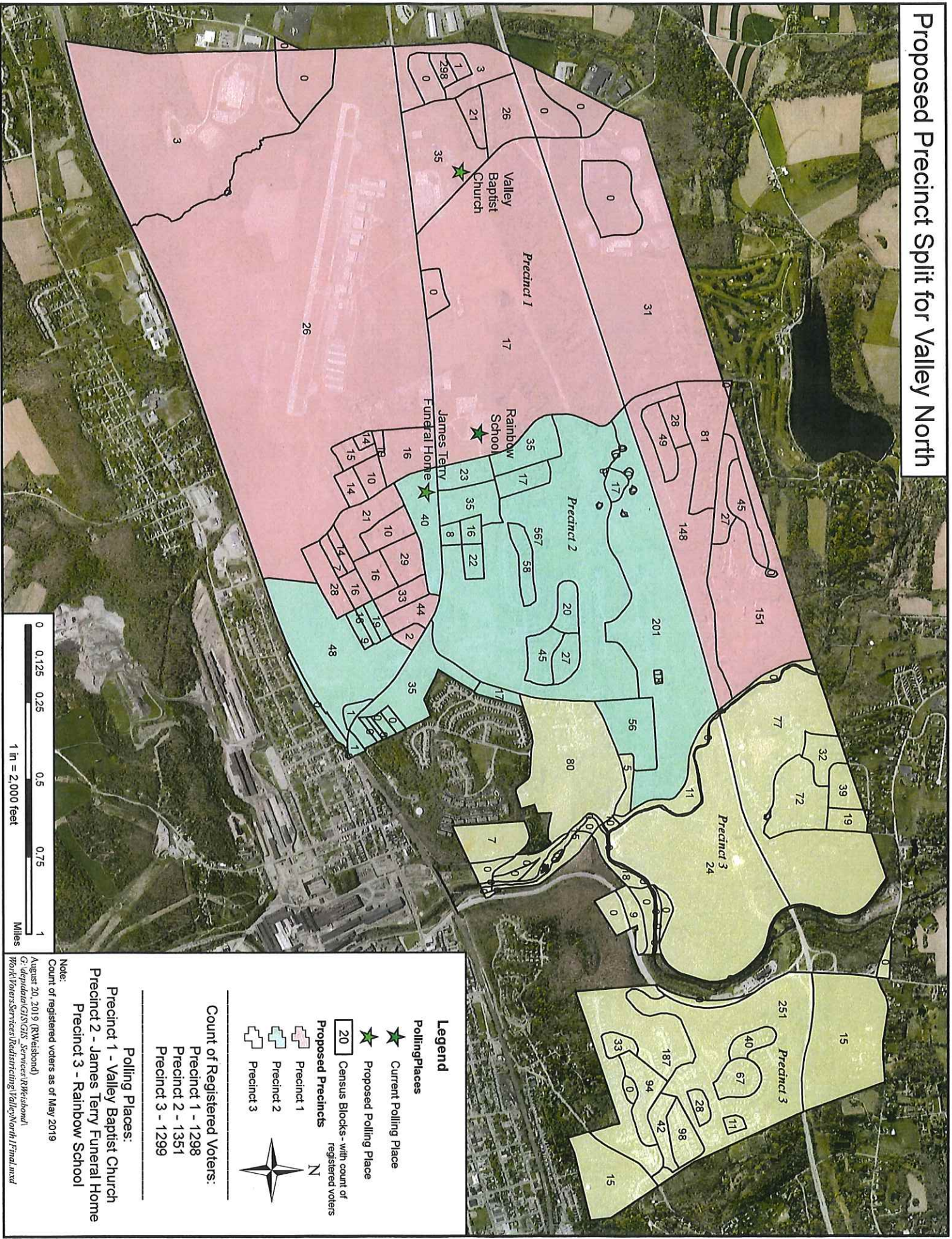
